FIRE HAZARD

In the event of a fire hazard on the premises of SGGW, in accordance with the instructions on how to proceed in the event of a fire, anyone who notices a fire is immediately obliged to:

- * alert people in the fire hazard zone,
- * notify the Fire Brigade by telephone 998 or 112
- * mechanically pressing the ROP button

EMERGENCY SITUATIONS WHEN PERFORMING EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Situations with a direct threat to life / health

Situation involving: physical altercation, scuffle, use of dangerous tools e.g., a person breaking glass intending to harm themselves or others), suicide attempts (e.g., a student standing by a window threatening to jump).

ORDER OF NOTIFICATION

1. Emergency numbers: 112 (EU Emergency Number), 999(Ambulance), 997 (Police)
2. Academic Guard (22) 593 39 00 or 604 605 319

Situations without direct element of a threat to life / health

A dangerous situation which cannot be “managed” or controlled by a lecturer but without a direct threat element e.g., an altercation between individuals, theft, or any other situation without a physical confrontation. Such situations should be dealt in accordance to the disciplinary scheme.
